2018 Remembrance Day Bendigo

REMEMBRANCE DAY COMMEMORATIVE SERVICE SUNDAY 11TH NOVEMBER 2018

The Bendigo District RSL Sub-Branch Inc would like to extend an invitation to members of your organization to attend and participate in the Bendigo Remembrance Day Commemorative Service to be held on the forecourt of the Soldiers Memorial Institute Military Museum (SMIMM). If you wish to participate in the march, the details are as follows:

As 2018 marks 100 years of Armistice, we will be re-enacting the events that took place in Bendigo following the signing of the Armistice on 11th November 1918 which constituted a solemn march and service to commemorate the returned and fallen soldiers. The original march took place from the Town Hall to the Queen Elizabeth Oval. Considering the age and abilities of our participants, we will be instead, marching to the forecourt of the SMIMM.

Members are welcome to assemble as a unit at the Bendigo Town Hall on Hargreaves Street no later than 9.30 am. The parade RSM will call "Right Marker" for the main body of the parade to prepare for assembling on the road. The next word of command will be "Parade Fall In". Following at 9.45 am the march will begin and will proceed down Bull Street towards the Midland Highway, turning left onto the Midland Highway and into Pall Mall concluding in front of the SMIMM.

The service held by the Bendigo District RSL Sub-Branch Inc. will commence at 10.30 am at the SMIMM following the conclusion of the march for veterans, servicemen and servicewomen.

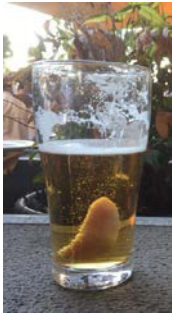
A number of speakers gave a great picture of Rhys's life, a life he lived to the fullest. Many of the stories could not be repeated.
